Self Study Findings: Areas of Strength

- Mission and Goals aligned with Institutional priorities and appropriate to higher education
- Highly qualified faculty staff who demonstrate PCUPR's commitment to an excellent education
- Robust academic curriculum
- Student support services enhance the chances to achieve their goals



Self Study Findings: Areas of Strength

- Attention is paid to the research area, which benefits students and faculty
- Resilience establishing a support system to address the emotional and academic needs of students, faculty, and administrative staff.
- Planning and Budgeting processes are linked to the available resources and the budget based on the objectives established in the Strategic Plan.



Self Study Recommendations: Attention to Student Needs

- Foster connections with alumni
 - Provide internships and exchange experiences to students
- Assertive communication plan
 - Close communication gaps and promote student support services opportunities
- Promote greater participation of faculty in academic guidance and enrollment processes

Self Study Recommendations: Attention to Student Needs (cont.)

- Improve the tutoring services assessment process
 - Expand and strengthen offerings
- Expand course offerings



Self Study Recommendations: Curriculum and Research

- Create a faculty development institute
 - Development plan: teaching strategy, assessment, emerging technology, research, proposal development
- Develop innovative certifications and degrees
 - Foster entrepreneurship, relevant to labor market needs, and reflect current population changes.



Self Study Recommendations: Curriculum and Research (cont.)

- Faculty exchanges
 - Strengthen collaborative alliances, expand international experience and recruitment.
- Strengthen research efforts and resources
 - Identify priority lines of research
 - Improve the research incentive for professors and students.



Self Study Recommendations: Human Resources, Administration, and Finance

- Strengthen the academic and administrative assessment culture
 - expand assessment training opportunities, improve the process to gather feedback and insights
- Establish a database system to gather information at the different institutional levels
 - Strengthen the decision-making processes and assess the institutional goals.

 - Employers, institutions, and others can trust our students have been sufficiently educated.
- Aligned to the agency standards and requirement of affiliation
 - Qualify for financial aid and federal loans under the USDE
- A degree from an accredited school is valuable.
